News From the Web Site

Exhibitions - The Midlands Model Engineering Exhibition at Learnington is provisionally arranged for October 14th -17th subject as above to confirmation by the organisers

Boiler Certs - We are still getting requests regarding the extension of certificates, quite simply the duration of certificates cannot be extended you need to get your steam or hydraulic tests done before the certificates expiry date, using a locomotive after this date I believe would almost certainly invalidate your insurance.

Boiler News - Boiler testers should be aware that from 1 Jan 2021, UK pressure vessel manufacturers may be using the UKCA mark instead of the EU CE mark. This new mark shall be treated under the boiler test code as a CE mark, as permitted under the Pressure Equipment Regulations Act. For vessels made after 1 Jan 2022, the EU CE mark is the only valid mark for boilers made in Europe and the UKCA mark is the only valid mark for boilers made in the UK. Owners of models should be aware that the position of recognition of the UKCA mark within Europe is not yet clear. This may affect those in the future if they are planning to take their model to Europe or to sell it there.

Amendments to Cover –

Effective 1st March 2021 MODELLING AND MODEL ENGINEERING CLUBS AND SOCIETIES INSURANCE Public and Products Liability Section Your insurers, *Travellers Insurance*, have introduced a change to the limit of indemnity for members provided under the Public/Products Liability section of your policy. The change restricts the limit of indemnity provided under your club & society policy, where members are carrying out modelling and model engineering activities in a personal capacity, to £1m and to £2m in the aggregate and in any one period of insurance. Where members are carrying out modelling and model engineering activities that are club activities, the normal club limit of indemnity applies as shown in the schedule of insurance.

Example: If a member takes his loco to run at another track as a private individual not as a club member and not as a club activity and an incident happens which results in the member being sued the applicable limit of indemnity will be £1m and the most the most the 7

The actual policy wording is: - We will cover on behalf of any member who is not indemnified by you for any claim which is first made in the period of insurance for accidental injury or damage arising from modelling/model engineering activities carried out by that member in their personal capacity and which is totally unrelated to any claim that has resulted in the partial or total exhaustion of the policy limit of indemnity. For the purpose of this endorsement only, modelling/model engineering activities include modelling/model engineering club/society, modelling/model engineering activities of all and every kind. The maximum amount we will pay under this extension is $\pounds1,000,000$ per claim and $\pounds2,000,000$ in annual aggregate. This member additional limit is in addition to, and not part of the policy limit of indemnity.

Subject otherwise to all terms, conditions and exclusions of the policy In order to avoid any issues should the £1m limit be exhausted, members may take out their own 'top up' Public Liability cover. They are then able to select a higher limit of indemnity to cover their activities carried out in a personal capacity.

No proposal forms to complete, cover is in force straight away and documents available there and then to either download or emailed – 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

By using this link, they will ensure that their policy is linked to the Northern Association of Model Engineers and help provide valuable income to the Northern Association, which helps keep the hobby going for their enjoyment and for future generations of Modellers and Model Engineers.

Cover for £5m Public Liability starts from as little as £29.59 inc 12% IPT per annum (no administration fee applies) and it is also possible to include cover for models, tools, home workshops and the like.
